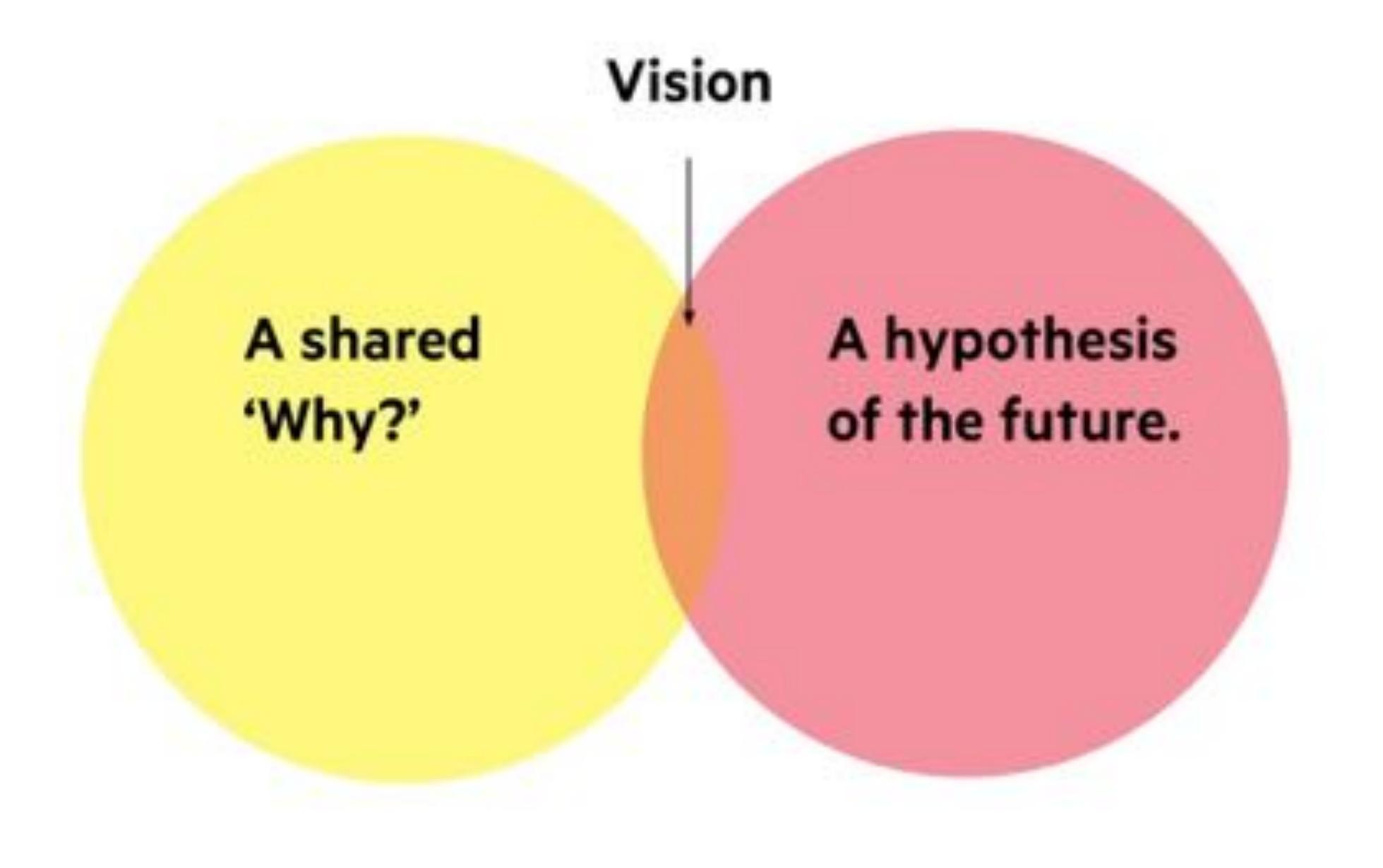
The problem with the future is we can't see it.
